The Keiper Accordion Orcheatra was FOUNDED IN 1970. The Present conductor is Jürgen Dorsch, who became the soloist Accordion Champion of Germany having also received top rankings as duo player and ensemble CONDuctor. The orchestra has made two PREVIOUS CONCERT TOURS OF THE US. THEIR REPERTOIRE INCLUDES CLASSICAL, POP, FOLK, AND MODERN MUSIC WHICH THEY HAVE PERFORMED ON Broadcasts in Germany and ON CD ReCORDINGS.

The German compound Gesangurrenskapelie stands for a COMBINATION OF ChOIR MUSIC and brass band music. In 1954 the choral society Gesangurein (founded in 1862) founded a brass band and Gesanguereinskapelle was born. In 1988, the Gesanguirenshapflle and the Akkordeonorchester Kelper toured the east coast, giving concerts in New York, Philadelphia, and Washington, DC. In recent years, the brass band's television and radio performances have met with enthusiasm. Heiko Opp, the condoctor, received first prize as a soloist at the national compettion dugend musiziert in 1983 and was awarded first prize three times with his ensemble at the German orchestra competition.
